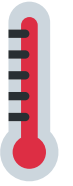




WARM WEATHER PET TIPS



1. PROVIDE PLENTY OF WATER AND SHADE

2. KNOW THE SIGNS OF DEHYDRATION

- HEAVY PANTING
- DRY OR BRIGHT RED GUMS
- THICK DROOL
- VOMITING
- DIARRHEA
- WOBBLY LEGS


3. NEVER LEAVE YOUR PET IN THE CAR


4. MIND YOUR WALKING HOURS

IF YOU HAVE A DOG, WALK AND EXERCISE YOUR PUP ONLY IN THE EARLY MORNING AND LATE EVENING. NEVER DO IT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE DAY. WHEN OUTSIDE, TAKE BREAKS IN THE SHADE AND HAVE WATER AVAILABLE.


5. TREAT YOUR PET FOR PARASITES

IN SUMMER, FLEAS, TICKS, MOSQUITOES, AND OTHER PARASITES ARE PRACTICALLY EVERYWHERE.

Even in the shade, the temperature in the car can still soar quickly to *dangerous levels.*



Leaving the windows open has *little effect* on how hot it is inside the car.
